Re: **Recommendation for Victoria Sublette.**

Victoria Sublette worked in the Eport engineering group since January 1991. Victoria was in charge of characterizing new color printers and calibrating existing ones. A lot of the data used by the characterization and calibration procedures had to be generated with various graphic applications on the Macintosh. The actual processing involved running in-house UNIX programs as well as PC/DOS programs. A major part of the work involved usage of color measurement tools, such as colorimeters and densitometers. The preparation of a printer characterization required an extremely precise measurements work, that may have taken up to few days. Victoria has never failed to accomplish any of these tasks. During her work period Victoria helped to set and document the characterization and calibration procedures. Due to the preliminary stage of part of the tools, Victoria's work has been frequently frustrating (bugs in programs, human mistakes that require second and third time measurements etc.). Victoria's cheerful cooperation and her sincere interest/involvement in the process made this whole process a success.

Victoria is a very dedicated worker who contributes whatever is required for the success of a project she is responsible for. When necessary, Victoria stayed long extra hours to meet tight schedules that were imposed on the group. Victoria's integration in the engineering department was remarkably smooth, as if she always belonged there. With her devotion to work, her communication skills and her natural cheerfulness, Victoria is a pleasant person to work with as a supervisor as well as a colleague.

I warmly recommend Victoria as a dedicated worker, who is fast to learn and to accomplish new projects in a challenging environment.
